The history of the **Deerfield and Roundabout Railway** at the Kennedy Road location originated in 1977 when Edward "Bud" Buker and a group of railway enthusiasts created the railway in then unincorporated Lake County, Illinois. Building and operating 1:8 scale model steam locomotives pulling trains of passenger and freight cars on approximately 10,000 feet of 7 and 1/2 inch gauge railway track.

The D. & R. Ry. has provided uninterrupted annual steam powered train operations since its inception. To this day it continues to serve as an outdoor laboratory for members of the Lake Forest Live Steamers Railway Museum, and others interested, to witness, experiment and to put into practice, on a reduced scale, railway construction and operating techniques used in the United States during the railway "steam era" of the first half of the Twentieth Century.
